Applying an instruction found in Playing Music (CAESAR SHIFT EACH REMOVED LETTER FORWARD BY NUMBER OF ITS CLUE) to the removed letters spells the message FIRST NAME FOR MUSICS THE KING, cluing the answer ELVIS.

The assembled Pieces leave a void in the grid, shaded above. This piece is identical to the upper left area of the grid in Stealing Eggs. Reading the odd letters in the corresponding region of that puzzle's letter grid spells IT'S CONSUL.
