

COLLECTING SHELLS (META) - ECLIPSING EACH OTHER

The nine answers to this puzzle set each require two puzzles to interface with each other in various ways; refer to individual puzzle answers for more detail. Each puzzle pairs with exactly two other puzzles to produce two answers, thus the answers can be chained into a loop:

Playing Ball	LATEX	Visiting the Underworld
Visiting the Underworld	TAMP	Killing Each Other
Killing Each Other	REDO	Hunting and Fishing
Hunting and Fishing	MASSACRED	Swimming
Swimming	OVERLY	Playing Music
Playing Music	ELVIS	Going to the Palace
Going to the Palace	CONSUL	Stealing Eggs
Stealing Eggs	TERI	Wandering in the Jungle
Wandering in the Jungle	HERE WE ARE	Playing Ball

The starting point and direction of the loop is ambiguous, but there's only one orientation in which the loop of answers fits into the shell necklace diagram, one letter per shell, with larger pairs of shells separating each answer. The order listed above begins at the top of the necklace and proceeds clockwise.

Using the smaller sun or moon beads as dividers between words, the loop can be read as two different word sequences, filling in the numbered shells as required:

Sun: EX [1] T • AMP [E] RE • DO [G] MAS • SACRED • [L] OVERLY • [P] ELVIS • [I] CONS • UL [S] TER • I [N] HERE • WEAR
• E [C] LAT

Moon: TEX [T] • TAMP [E] RED • O [H] M • ASS • ACRE • D [R] OVER • LY [E] • ELVIS [H] • CONSUL [A] TE • RI [C] HER •
EWE • ARE [O] LA

Ordering the added Sun and Moon letters by their assigned numbers spells the solution, ECLIPSING / EACH OTHER.
