

PLAYING MUSIC - OVERLY (with Swimming) / ELVIS (with Going to the Palace)

Words can be found in the grid as shown at right. Unused letters provide an instruction (CAESAR SHIFT EACH REMOVED LETTER FORWARD BY NUMBER OF ITS CLUE) to be applied to the puzzle Going to the Palace.

Found entries can be grouped in sets of five related to the nine genres of music listed. The letters indexed within the entries for each genre spell an album, and the underlined number within each set references a particular track on that album. Each track contains the name of a river. These are the nine starting entries for the same-numbered track in Swimming, providing a way to break into that puzzle.

1. HIP-HOP (jumping animals)
Lunatic Frame / PO River

2. GRUNGE (dirtiness)
Sinatra Swings / Moonlight on the GANGES

3. COUNTRY (nations)
Judy at Carnegie Hall / SWANEE

4. BIG BAND (enormous circles)
Surfer Rosa / River EUPHRATES

5. LATIN (Latin phrases)
A Recent Future / Cold MISSOURI Waters

6. ROCK (gems)
Jupiter's Darling / The NILE Song

7. POP (TV dads)
Where Moth and Rust Destroy / Healing Waters of the TIGRIS

8. BLUES (shades of blue)
Watermark / ORINOCO Flow

9. GOSPEL (Bible books)
2001: A Space Odyssey / The Blue DANUBE
