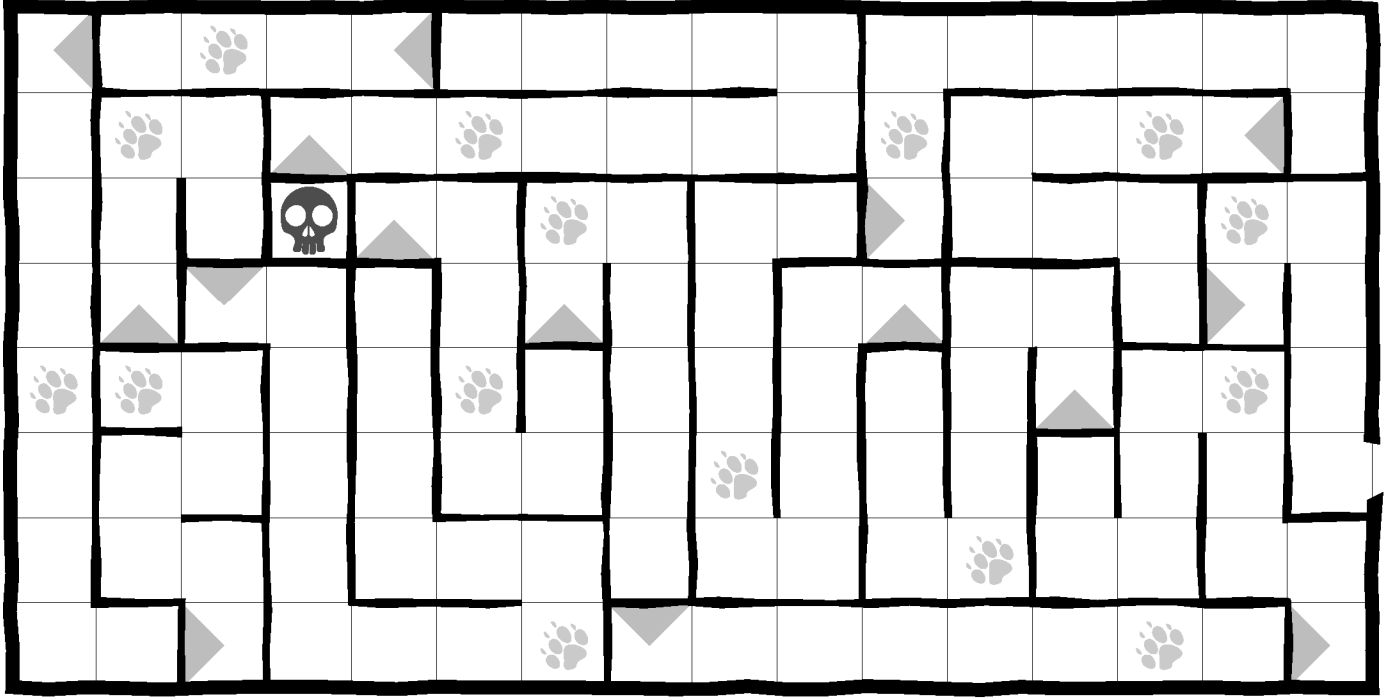


THE BURIAL VAULT
