


## **SOLUTION:**

The reference to the grapes being "too far...too far!" is meant to suggest that this is a "Going Too Far" crossword; that is, one in which some entries extend into a black square before or after their numbered space. In the completed grid, the longest across and down entries spell the instruction "Assemble six by six black box bit by bit." Using the filled black squares as jigsaw pieces (note that, per clue 54A, there are twelve pieces, so the diagonally adjacent pairs of boxes each count as one piece), a block can be formed as shown. This spells a clue to the final answer: "Once sulfuric acid was referred to as oil of "... VITRIOL (which the fox is certainly

spewing).
