

Results from correctly restoring each mutated string (as explained below) yield a series of letter strings that are each one letter off from a particular writing system. Correct letters, in string order, spell the clue EYE THIS ON WIKIPEDIA. What article could this refer to? Actually, this refers to the Wikipedia logo itself, depicted as an unfinished globe assembled from jigsaw pieces. Each of these has a letter on it from a different writing system (the writing system's closest equivalent to "W"). The 18 writing systems represented on the globe are those used in this puzzle; using the globe logo, they can be mapped to the diagram at the bottom of the puzzle (shaded spaces on that grid represent pieces of the globe that aren't visible in its standard view, while dotted lines indicate missing pieces). Adjusting the incorrect letters by the values given spells the message SOLUTION'S NFL PLAYER.
